

Verdun Adventure Bound

Description of Facilities and Intended Uses

Greenhouse: Propagation of native plant materials for use on Verdun property. Plants may be used for non-commercial purposes outside the Verdun property when available. Includes a small Classroom (24 person capacity) and environmental demonstration area.

Multiple Purpose Building: Restroom Facilities for general use. Restrooms augmented by Portable Toilet structures when necessary. **Additional charges apply for the portable units.** One small meeting room on the East side of the building is primarily for Verdun Staff use for planning meetings and development processes and may also serve as a first aid station although medical facilities are very limited. An emergency phone is located on the outside of the building and only the 911 numbers are operative. A small office for Camp operations and maintenance material storage is also within this building.

Education Conference Center Building: Meeting, Classroom and Warming Kitchen facility. Two classrooms (20 person capacity) and the Large (Great) room with fireplace and (120 person capacity). Warming Kitchen, facilities are very limited and intended to be for holding and serving only.

Pavilion: Located near the pond this covered concrete area with fireplace, fire ring, water faucet, electricity and limited barbeque type cooking facilities (60 person capacity).

Gazebo and docks: Located adjacent to the pond near the canoe / kayak house. Fire ring, small covered area on the docks. (15 person capacity).

MAP LOCATIONS

The Verdun map is divided into three zones (improved, primitive, wilderness). Zones are divided into smaller activity areas shown on the map by orange borders designated by an orange number within a circle.

Campsites: Designated by a number showing the “area” location on the Map, and a blue circle containing a letter designating the site itself, i.e. 2A

ACTIVITY AREAS

Areas 1 thru 13, located West of DELRIDGE RUN, are considered to be in the ***IMPROVED ZONE***. Trails are more open, better maintained and more easily traveled. Safe water source hydrants are available and the modern improvements are here.

Areas 14 thru 20, located East of DELRIDGE RUN, are considered to be in either the ***PRIMITIVE ZONE (areas 14 thru 17) or WILDERNESS ZONE (areas 18 thru 20)***. In the PRIMITIVE area the trails are fairly open. In the Wilderness area trails are less obvious. No designated Safe water points are available. Sanitary Facilities are limited to Portable Toilets.

Pond: Located in the improved Area: Approximately 3 Acres. Three small fishing piers, one expanded dock, Gazebo area with fire ring. Pre-Approved Water Activity safety plan must be in place for all users at all times. Canoes and Kayaks are available for an additional fee.

Wetland: Located on the flood plain of Delridge Run approximately 2 acres. Controlled water capture to manage the ground growth of plant materials as a wildlife food source.
