Reservation Procedure

Verdun Adventure Bound is an organization camp. There is no process for an individual to become a camper. Individuals who desire to be campers at Verdun must be registered with an organization that is requesting the use of the camp. Interested groups from Churches, Schools, Civic and business Organizations etc may make use of the facilities after completing the reservation / registration process. The facilities are limited to day or evening use of education center buildings and outdoor activities. Overnight stays are limited to primitive camping (campers provide their own tents).

Reservation Policy: All requests must include a 30% non-refundable deposit. At the discretion of the Verdun Board of Directors a deposit for a canceled reservation date may be applied to a new date. Since some groups make reservations with long lead times, dates may be changed up to twelve weeks in advance of arrival date. Date changes with less than twelve weeks notice forfeit the deposit. Reservations do not exist until a letter of commitment and the deposit have been received at Verdun Office. Our staff will send the confirmation letter to the designated contact individual. Informal confirmation will be sent upon request via phone and / or email if sufficient information is provided with the request form.

Once a reservation is accepted, confirmation of activities, safety requirements and other issues appropriate to your group and its plans will be required. **This includes proof of insurance and liability release forms for all participants.** The release form can be downloaded (<http://www.verdunadventurebound.org/forms.asp>) and printed locally so your group can have plenty of time to obtain signatures etc. Forms must be in our file or turned in on arrival (prior to participation in any activities).
